Rules of the Road



- Roadways are under the jurisdiction of the Isle of Palms Police Department and Wild Dunes Security.
- Vehicles must yield to pedestrians in marked crosswalks.
- Speed limits are strictly enforced.
- Parking is allowed in designated areas only.
- Parking is not allowed on Palmetto Drive, Back Bay Drive or in cul-de-sacs.
- Motorcycles, mopeds, scooters and other 2 or 3 wheeled motorized vehicles are not permitted.
- Motor homes are not permitted.
- Golf carts must be identified with both a South Carolina registration permit and a current Wild Dunes decal.
- LSVs (low speed vehicles) must have a South Carolina license plate and a current Wild Dunes decal.
- You must be a licensed driver to operate a golf cart or LSV.
- Golf carts and LSVs are not allowed on the pedestrian, bike or beach access paths.
- Golf carts are required to pull over, stop and give the right-of-way to vehicles approaching from behind.

Trash and Recycling



- Trash from single family homes is collected on Tuesdays (and Fridays from Memorial Day through Labor Day).
- Roll-out carts should be placed at the curb the evening prior to scheduled pick-up, but no earlier than 5:00 p.m.
- Condos and Villas trash receptacles are centrally located on their property.
- Recycling pick-up is every other Wednesday.
- Recycling receptacles are also located behind the Sweetgrass Pavilion in the Resort Core Area and at the Isle of Palms Marina on 41st Avenue.

Wildlife and Environment



- It is illegal to feed or harass alligators. Be aware of coyotes, especially after dusk and before dawn.
- For your safety, swimming in lagoons is not permitted. Do not allow children or pets near lagoon banks because of the presence of alligators.
- Please "remember lights out" on front beach during Loggerhead turtle season (May - October).

Beach

The Beach is the Wild Dunes Community's most important asset. Our number one objective is protection and sustainability of the beach for all to enjoy. Please help us maintain this goal by adhering to the following:

- Use designated beach access paths when going to the beach (no golf carts are allowed on the paths).
- Stay off the sand dunes as they are the first natural defense against coastal storms.
- Do not disturb the sand fences and sea grasses as these facilitate natural dune formation.
- It is illegal to pick, disturb or destroy sea oats.
- The beach is a seasonal nesting ground for Loggerhead turtles. Nests are marked by turtle team volunteers. Never approach the nests or the hatchlings returning to the ocean.
- Ocean tides and currents can be very dangerous. Do not get stranded on a sandbar during an incoming tide. Do not swim in Dewees Inlet. Be aware of rip current warnings from local media.

Rental Guests



- The Owners' Beach House is private property and may not be used by rental guests.
- Short-term rental guests may not bring pets into the community.
- Open flames and grilling on wooden decks or porches are not permitted within condo and townhouse facilities.
- Hanging towels and clothing from balconies or railings is not permitted.
- The Isle of Palms has the following ordinances which are strictly enforced:
 - no alcohol on the beach
 - no plastics
 - no excessive noise
 - no smoking
 - no fireworks
 - no fires on the beach
 - no soliciting
 - no littering on the beach - trash receptacles are provided at all beach access paths
 - no personal property may be left on the beach after sunset
- Please adhere to these guidelines for your safety and the protection of the beach and wildlife on the island.
